College of Liberal Arts and Sciences Individualized Major

The Individualized Major consists of at least 36 credits of 2000-level and higher (before 2008: 200-level) course work in two or more departments, with a minimum of 18 credits from courses offered by departments in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. None may be taken Pass/Fail.

- An IMJR plan may include no more than six credits of independent study nor more than 12 credits of field work.
- An IMJR plan must be interdisciplinary in content with an overall coherence of subject matter, and it must be of academic merit.
- The major may include only credits earned in UConn courses (defined as courses taken at UConn or in a UConn Study Abroad or Study Away program); very limited exceptions may be permitted with the Dean's permission.
- A minimum of a 2.5 GPA in your 36 credit major is required for graduation.
- All majors must complete an approved capstone course: they must register for INTD 4600W or INTD 4697W for honors or other students writing a thesis. (Double majors and additional degree students may meet the capstone requirement by substitution if they register for a capstone or thesis in the final year of their other major.)
- To satisfy information literacy competency requirements, all majors must take INTD 4600W [295W], INTD 4697W [296W], or an approved substitute. In addition all majors must include one research methods or research course in their plans of study. (Double majors and additional degree students may choose to satisfy the information literacy competency outside the Individualized Major.)
- To satisfy the writing in the major requirement, all students must nominate one other 2000-level or higher course in a relevant academic discipline (where feasible this course should be a W course) and in addition take INTD 4600W [295W] (or INTD 4697W [296W]). (Double majors and additional degree students may choose to satisfy the exit level writing in the major competency outside the Individualized Major.)

Note: The Bachelor of Science Degree: The proposed plan of study must consist of at least 24 course credits at the 2000-level or higher (before 2008: 200-level) from the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences in science, mathematics, and/or statistics departments. Students must complete an acceptable general science sequence including courses in Chemistry, Math, Physics and Biology, as specified below.
